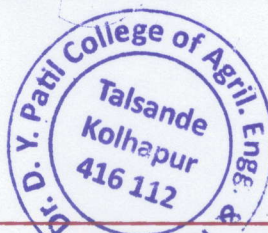
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

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

1. To ensure full compliance with Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri guidelines for prevention and prohibition of ragging.
2. To maintain continuous vigilance and preventive monitoring by conducting regular inspections and surprise visits in hostels, classrooms, canteens, laboratories, bus stops, parking areas, playgrounds and all vulnerable areas on the campus.
3. To organize orientation programs, awareness workshops, seminars, and training sessions for students and staff to sensitize them about anti-ragging policies, consequences of ragging, and disciplinary measures.
4. To ensure that anti-ragging notices, banners, posters, helpline numbers and complaint procedures are prominently displayed across the campus and included in the admission prospectus and institutional website.
5. To establish easily accessible and confidential complaint mechanisms for reporting incidents of ragging.
6. To receive, examine and promptly investigate all complaints of ragging with strict confidentiality and fairness.
7. To recommend appropriate disciplinary action based on investigation findings, which may include suspension, expulsion, rustication, cancellation of admission, withholding results or scholarships, hostel expulsion, debarment from campus activities or FIR lodging with police authorities.
8. To implement collective punishment in cases where individual perpetrators cannot be identified but evidence of ragging exists.
9. To ensure immediate medical attention, psychological counselling and emotional support is provided to victims of ragging and to keep their parents informed about the situation and necessary actions.
10. To maintain proper records of all inspections, complaints received, investigations conducted, actions taken and minutes of committee meetings.
11. To submit periodic reports to the University authorities, Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri, UGC and other regulatory bodies as required.
12. To convene regular meetings of the Anti-Ragging Committee to review the effectiveness of preventive measures, analyze complaints and update policies as per changing guidelines or campus requirements.
13. To ensure that every member actively participates and discharges their assigned duties in maintaining a safe, disciplined and ragging-free campus environment.
