9. Celebration of Jijamata & Swami Vivekanand Jayanti 12th January, 2021

The **Jijamata & Swami Vivekanand Jayanti** was celebrated with great zeal in Dr. D. Y. Patil Agricultural Engineering & Technology, Talsande on 12th January, 2021. Dr. S. B. Patil, Principal, Er. P. D. Ukey, Academic In Charge, Prof. S. M. Patil NSS Program Officer, DYP CAET, Talsande greeted the image of Jijamata & Swami Vivekanand on the occasion.

Dr. S. B. Patil in his speech said that, **Rajmata Jijau** was the Matoshree of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of the Hindavi empire. **Jijau** Maa Saheb was born on 12th January 1598 in the Bhuikot palace. Today her birth place is not only a historical place but also a tourist destination. He also showed a gratitude for her determination towards **Swaraj**.

Er. . D. Ukey in his speech said that, **Swami Vivekananda** was born on 12th January 1863. He was a chief disciple of the 19th century after Indian mystic Ramakrishna. He was a key figure in the introduction of the Indian philosophies of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world, and is credited with raising interfaith awareness, bringing Hinduism to the status of a major world religion during the late 19th century. He was a major force in the contemporary Hindu reform movements in India, and contributed to the concept of Indian nationalism as a tool to fight against the British empire in colonial India. Vivekananda founded the Ramakrishna Math and the Ramakrishna Mission. He is perhaps best known for his speech which began with the words "**Sisters and brothers of America**" in which he introduced Hinduism at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago in 1893.
